TRANSPORT

Car Park (Otopark)

For periods less than 2hrs the Belediyesi car park is cheapest. Over 2hrs, use the flat rate carpark.

Dolmuş (Summer hour estimates)

- Every 20-30 minutes to Bodrum
 - Every 15-20 minutes to Turgutreis
 - Every 30-45 minutes to Yalikavak
- * Current timetable will be posted at the Dolmuş Station

ACTIVITIES

Snorkeling/Swimming

A narrow, fine sand and pebble beach, with a small bay that is roped-off and protected from boat traffic.

Rabbit Island

Head to the point between the two bays, to walk across the underwater causeway to visit Rabbit Island.

5

Craft Market "El Sanatları Carsisi"

Covered arcade of small artisan stalls, and adjacent shops, selling a unique selection of crafts.

6

Boat Trip

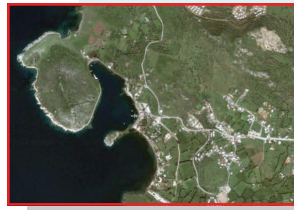
Daily departures. Trips 11am-6pm. Walk to the harbour and head to the jetty.

Municipal Art Center

Located across from the Belediyesi Tea Garden

NEARBY

Head to Gümüşlük Village. Turn left at the Karapınar Junction and hike up to the old village of **Karakaya**.

Follow the curve of the Harbour, and hike up the hill for great views of the bay & Rabbit Island

RESTAURANTS

Gümüşlük is renowned for its seafood, and restaurants line both the harbour and the beach.

Before you choose where to eat, explore the options to find a restaurant with the ambiance and price range you're looking for.

In the evenings, you can dine harbour-side, or enjoy the sunset from a restaurant on the beach—sipping an ice cold Efes from your table on the sand.
