~DISTANCES TO Bitez Bay

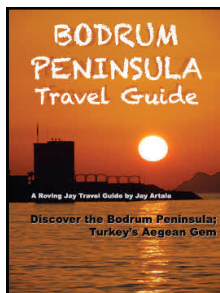


BODRUM	6 km

TRANSPORT

Taxi Ranks

1

Car Parks (Otopark)

As well as Car Parks, there is free street parking

Dolmuş

(Peak Summer hour estimates*)

Every 15-20 min. to Bodrum & Aktur*

(Updated Times at the Dolmus station)

ACTIVITIES

Snorkeling/Swimming

Shallow water, great for families. 3 distinct beach locations in the bay

4

Water Sports Centres

Popular bay for water sports, with plenty of activities to choose from

5

Bicycle Rental

Rent by the day, hour, week or month. Office is located right on the beach.

6

Day Boat Harbour & Jetty

Daily Boat Trip departures at 10:00 & 10.30am, returning ~5:00pm. Most schedule a stop at Aquarium Bay.

Small recreational craft and dive boat moored at the Jetty.

7

Art & Craft Market Stalls

Located down various side streets. Selling local handicrafts and souvenirs

8

Weekly & Sunday Market/Pazar

Weekly Farmers Market & 2nd Hand Flea Market held in Bitez Village

NEARBY

- ☉ Take a coastal walk from the harbour to reach secluded bays, or walk over the hill near the Sarnic to reach Aquarium Bay & Cove
- ☉ Walk amid the tranquil citrus groves north of the beach. Visit the old church ruins with the dolphin mosaics. Or go further afield and follow one of the tracks north to visit Bitez village
- ☉ Visit the neighbouring quiet bay of Aktur (west), or the more lively Gumbet (east)

☉ **Amenities:** Public Toilets; ATM's; Wi-Fi; Internet Cafes; Barbers; Hair Dressers and Manicure; Tattoo; Chemist; Laundromat; Car Hire; Travel Agents.

RESTAURANTS

R The main tourist hub is centered around the Mosque, and both Turkish & International restaurants line the pedestrian area running parallel to the beach.

There is also a variety of small cafés and bars around here too.

- ☉ Explore further along the bay in either direction, or venture onto any of the side streets (between the beach and Bergamut Cd.) and you'll find a good selection of local Turkish restaurants.
- ☉ Don't forget the Belediyesi Café by the day boat harbour (*local's favourite!*)
