

## BEACH TIPS

- Most of the beaches have sun-beds and umbrellas owned by the local bars or restaurants, which are free to use. But the expectation is that you'll order a drink or food while you use their beach facilities.
- Find the strip of beach you want to settle at, and somebody will stop-by to take your order.
- If you're swimming near rocks, keep a look out for sea urchins.
- Most Importantly:** Play your part to keep the beaches clean, and dispose of your litter responsibly!

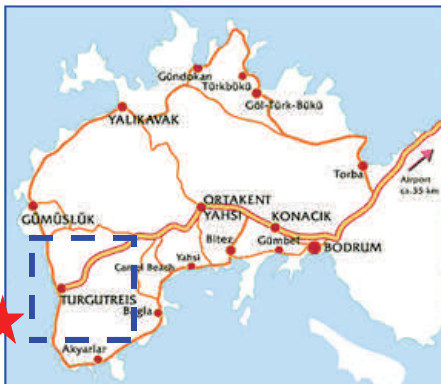


## TRANSPORT & DISTANCE



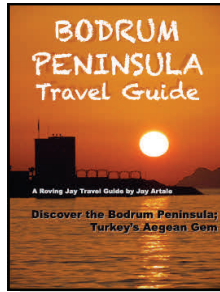
TURGUTREIS TO AKYARLAR ~9KM.

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## TURGUTREIS BEACHES

This guide covers the bays & beaches dotted along the coastal region of the Turgutreis Municipality.

The nearest beach is close to town, and the furthest is 10km away.

You can hop on a dolmuş, and explore! Or view them from the comfort of a Southern day-boat trip from Turgutreis

### Günbatımı Plajı

Closest beach to Turgutreis town center, with all of the amenities right on the doorstep. Great base for a day at the beach, with little breaks to wander around the local shops

### Palamut Plajı

The Golden Beach hotel section of this beach is designated as private, but the rest of the beach is public, and is perfect for a stroll to enjoy the view of the nearby islands

### Fener Plajı

This stretch of beach after the Lighthouse, is a popular windsurfing & kite-surfing spot. Fener Windsurf is located here. The southern part of the beach is fronted by resorts.

### Meteoroloji (Meteor) Plajı

The first bay on the southern tip of the Peninsula is Meteor Beach. It's ideally situated for a close-up view of Kos. The small peninsula of land to the East hosts Xanadu Island Resort.

### Akçabük Plajı

Nestled on the other side of Xanadu Island Resort is the sheltered Akçabük Bay, which has a short sandy beach.

## TURGUTREIS BEACHES

### Akyarlar Plajı

The largest town in this corner of the Peninsula, with a small harbor and boat trips. There's a weekly farmers market, as well as a good choice of restaurants & a few shops.

### Karaincir Plajı

This beach is nestled between hills and sheltered from the winds, making the bay really calm. The road veers a little inland near here, so careful not to miss this beach

## TURGUTREIS BEACHES

### Aspat Plajı

Home to the Temera Resort & Solida Beach Club. This beach is long and sandy. Walk across the small bridge to the East of the beach to start the hike up Aspat Hill.

## SIGHTS

### Country Ranch

Horse Riding Stables, offering treks into the locals hills. Located off the main Turgutreis to Bodrum road.

### Sabancı Park

Located just south of the Marina, this park honors Turgut Reis, the Town's namesake.

### Aspat Hill

Ancient Hamam at the base of this hill. Follow the steps & path up the hill, past the remaining castle ruins. At the top, you'll be awarded with amazing view of land and sea.

### Numerous Hiking Trails

You can hike one of the trails that stretch from Turgutreis to Akyarlar. This terrain is hilly (between 100-300m), but if you're not in a rush, it's a bracing way to travel this part of the coastline.
