Dolmuş

(Summer hour estimates*)

Kadikalesi is on the main dolmuş route between Turgutreis & Gümüşlük.

ACTIVITIES

Snorkeling/Swimming

Beach just south of Kadikale Resort, as well as narrow strips of beach and wooden jetties along the coastline (south)

Water Sports

Lots of options for different water sports in this small bay. Mornings are the best time to learn to windsurf as the water is flat, and the wind is gentle.

View Old Greek Church

This is the Peninsula's most intact Greek Church, perched on the hillside above Kadikalesi.

Turkish Bath & Resort Spas

Kadikale Resort & Yasmin Hotel have a Turkish Bath & other Spa services on-site.

NEARBY

Stroll South along the coastline to **Turgutreis**, which should take about 20-40 minutes, depending on your setting-off point.

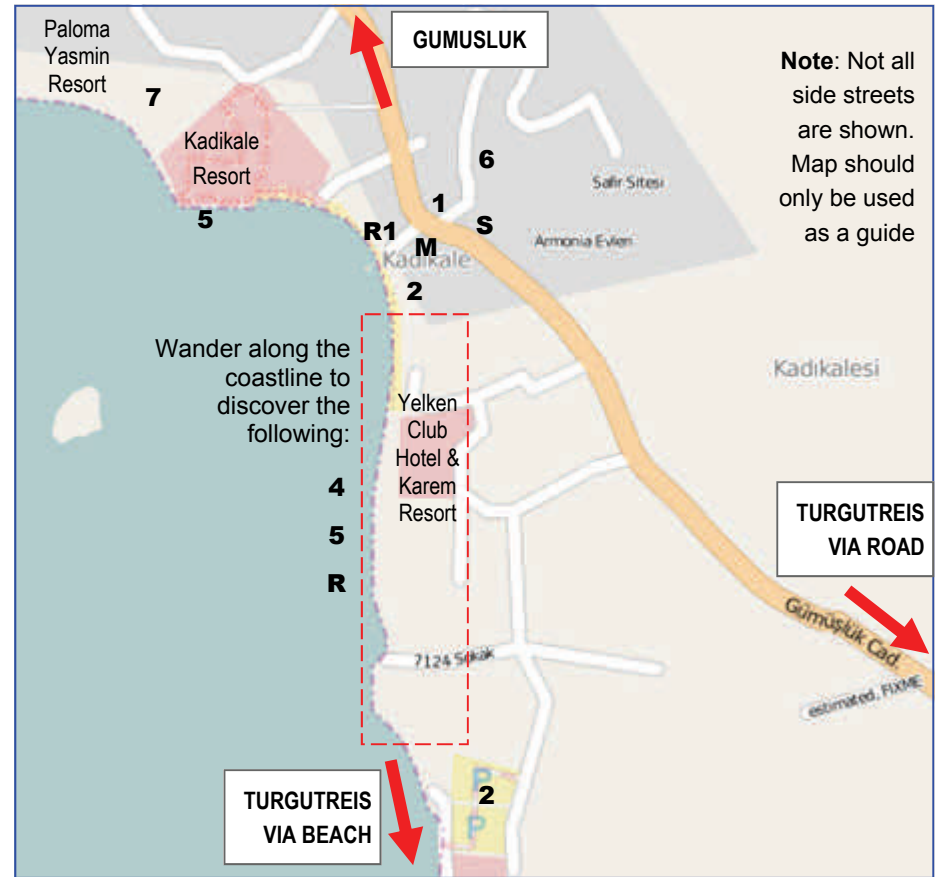
Hike up to the hill overlooking the town to view the scant ruins of **Kadi Kalesi**. This old Judge's Castle became the namesake for the

RESTAURANTS ETC.

A selection of some of the bars, cafes & restaurants in Kadikalesi:

- R1** The beach area inland from the Mosque has a hub of local cafes and restaurants:
- Korfez:** Right on the beach, with great seafood. One of the oldest establishments in the village.
- Çıpa:** Memorable Seafood, with a price to match, but worth it for a special occasion
- Naz Café:** Local Turkish cuisine.
- Cotto Café:** Away from the beach, near the main road. Great for breakfast or light lunch or supper.
- Nisan Café:** Mediterranean cuisine.

RESTAURANTS ETC.

- R** The coastline is dotted with cafes, bars & restaurants. Even more are tucked down the side-streets (and in the local resorts)
- Meyhane:** Good selection of local dishes, especially meze. Great bar & garden area. Live Music. (by main road)
- Yali:** Simple, Turkish cuisine at the waters edge, a firm favourite
- Pitos Bar:** Open fire-pit, in a garden setting.
- Kekik:** Tasty Pizza and Salads, at reasonable prices
- Deniz Ambari:** Good local dishes. Fish and Meze at reasonable prices
