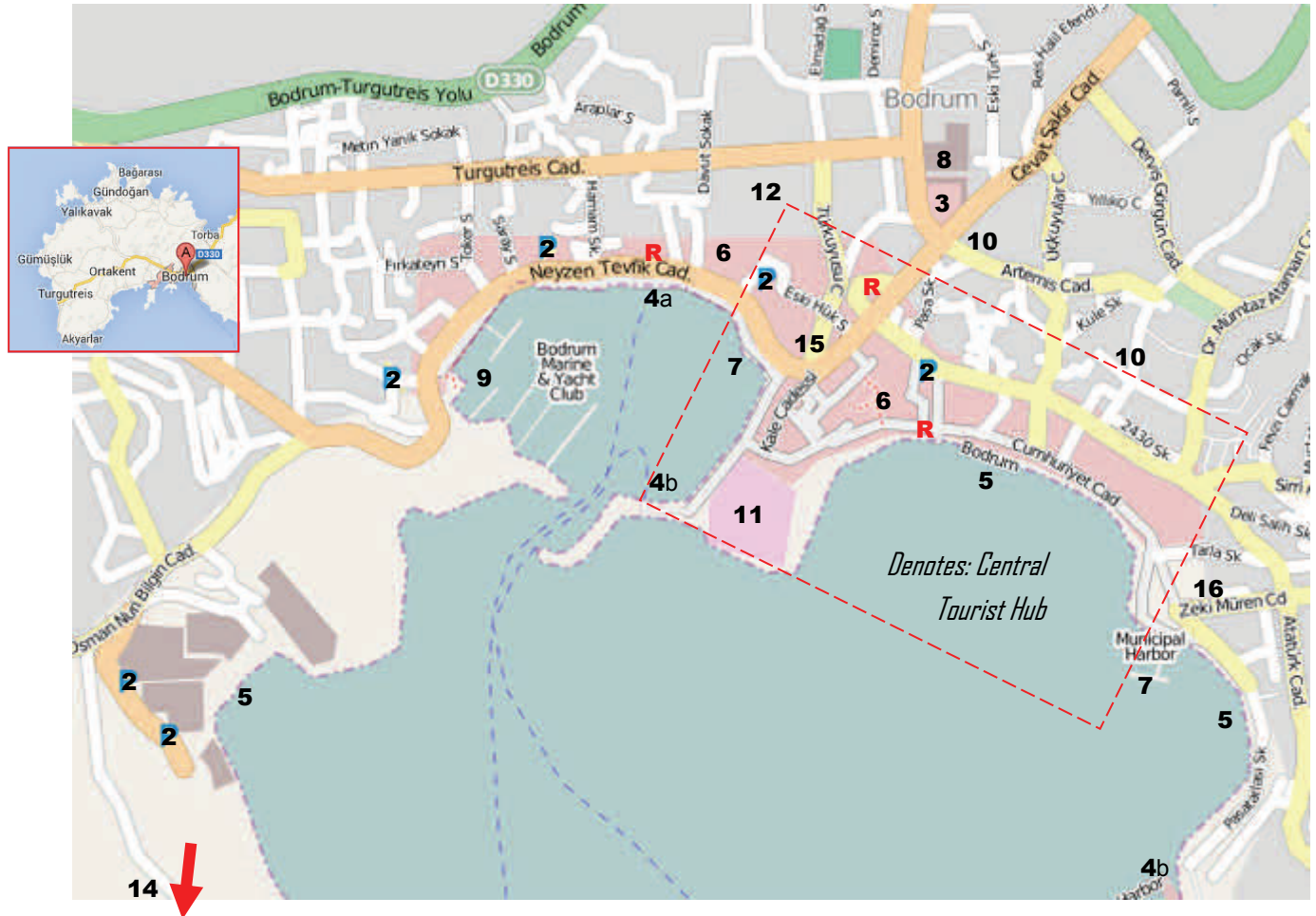

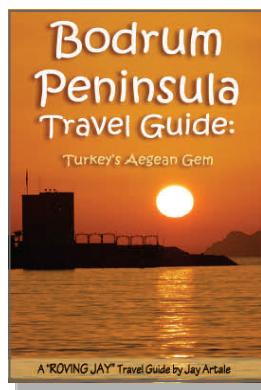


TURGUTREIS	19 km
